Notice is hereby given that Monaghan Town Council proposes to make Bye-Laws in relation to the control, regulation, supervision and administration of Casual Trading in the functional area of the Council and to designate the following site, situated in the townland of Roosky as a Casual Trading Area:

- Church Square North – opposite Courthouse, Monaghan Town.

A copy of the proposed draft Casual Trading (Control and Description) Bye-Laws and map will be available for inspection at the offices of Monaghan Town Council, Town Hall, 1 Dublin Street, Monaghan, County Monaghan between the hours of 9.30a.m. – 5.00p.m. Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays) for a period of 1 month from the date of publication of this notice. The Town Council will consider any submissions in relation to the proposed draft Casual Trading (Control and Description) Bye-Laws which are submitted in writing to it by any person within 2 weeks after the end of the period for inspection of the proposed bye-laws.
